Free energy assessment and match funding still available

All SMEs in Oxfordshire are entitled to apply for a fully funded energy assessment from Energy Solutions Oxfordshire (ESOx).

Businesses will receive a report with advice on a range of low and no cost actions they could take, with estimated costs and carbon savings, tailored to their business, along with recommendations for which low-carbon technologies are most suitable to their premises.

Businesses can then apply to the ESOx Green Fund for match funds of up to £10,000 towards the cost of measures recommended. The Fund has already funded over £25,000 of energy efficiency improvements for local SMEs.

Be ready for the next heat wave!

The chance of extreme heatwaves is rising in our changing climate, with flooding from rivers and surface water and putting pressure on infrastructure systems and environment.

Ice cream is always a good way to keep cool, but here are some other tips to help protect your business:

- Check your postcode to see if your area is vulnerable to extreme heat
- Sign up for email warnings from the Met Office of severe weather including thunder storms
- What to do if you get caught in a flash flood driving
- Know who to call in a power cut (call 105) and have a backup generator, battery equipment or power packs for if the power does go out

National Emergency Alert Test 7th September

At around 15:00 on Sunday 7th September 2025 an Emergency Alert will be sent to mobile phone across the UK in the second ever national test of system, as part of plans to strengthen the country's preparedness for emergencies.

The Emergency Alerts system is used to warn if there's a danger to life nearby, including extreme weather. It allows vital information and advice to be sent to people rapidly in an emergency.

This September, a new Shop Front Improvement Grant Scheme will open to support local independent businesses in upgrading and enhancing their premises. Whether it's a bold new sign, increasing customer seating, or restoring a traditional shopfront to its former glory, this scheme could help turn your plans into reality.

Funded through the UK Shared Prosperity Fund and the Rural England Prosperity Fund, the scheme will offer match-funded capital grants for projects that boost visual appeal, support footfall, and celebrate local character. It's all about helping high streets thrive — and it starts with great-looking businesses.

What can the funding cover?

- · Access improvements for accessibility
- External signage and lighting (with approvals)
- Awnings, canopies, umbrellas
- Planters and decorative street-level features
- New shopfront doors/windows



What should businesses do now?

With the application window opening in September, now is the ideal time to start preparing. That means:

- Thinking through design ideas
- Gathering quotes from suppliers
- Checking planning permission requirements and applying if necessary
- Getting your documents and business details in order

Grants will be awarded based on the project's impact, creativity and originality, and how well it enhances the character of the area — so strong, well-prepared applications will really stand out. With a total budget of £45,000, we're excited to support at least 45 local businesses with grants of up to £1,000 each. As demand is expected to be high, this will be a competitive process, so preparing your application early and making it shine will truly pay off!
